#### 19 Walking trail along River Venta

A 2.5 km long walking trail along the Venta riverbank connects the old brick bridge of Kuldīga with the new bridge. The viewpoints on the trail offer unusual views of the ancient bridge and the waterfall of Venta.

#### 20 Mārtiņsala. (a Blue Flag beach)

A beach with amenities, an active recreation area for children and adults, changing rooms, toilets and a health trail. Mārtiņsala is accessible for people with reduced mobility and is suitable for pushchairs.

#### 21 Tour bus "Rumba buss"

Guided tours (in Latvian, Russian, English and German) by a panoramic electric bus for groups and individual travellers, equipped with individual audio headsets for each traveller.

#### 22 Needle exhibition at the Industrial Heritage Tower and viewing platform

Part of the former Kuldīga needle factory "Meters". It now houses an industrial heritage exhibition and a roof platform.

#### 1 Venta Rapid

Europe's widest natural waterfall, with a width of 249 m and a height between 1.6 and 2.2 metres. In the spring and autumn, fish can be seen "flying" over the waterfall. *New* Venta Rapid to be illuminated every night as the dusk sets in. On some weekends, with prior announcement, you will be able to see light shows over the waterfall.

#### 2 The Old Brick Arch Bridge

Built in 1874, it is the longest (164 m) road bridge of its kind in Europe. It was built (500 feet long and 26 feet wide) to allow two carriages travelling opposite each other to cross it.

#### 3 Alekšupīte Waterfall

The recreation area with more than 15 sculptures by the sculptor Līvija Rezevska is located in the oldest part of Kuldīga, on the site of the former German Order and later Duke Jacob's castle.

#### 4 The Town Garden

#### 5 Kuldīga St. Catherine's Luth. Church

The oldest place of worship in Kuldīga (1252). A chance to climb the tower for a bird's-eye view of Kuldīga.

#### 6 Kuldīga District Museum

A house locally known as Bangerts' Villa. The first floor exhibition is arranged as an apartment – a take on the lifestyle of a wealthy local resident in the early 20th century, while on the second floor visitors can take a look into the history of the town in the exhibition "Kuldīga Before Us". #### 7 Kuldīga Old Town Hall with Town Hall Square

The Old Town Hall was built in the second half of the 17th century and housed a prison in its dungeons, but today it hosts a weaving workshop, an exhibition hall with various exhibitions, an open fire hearth and a tourist information centre.

#### 8 Art Centre and Library

The former synagogue complex, consisting of three buildings – a synagogue (1875), a house of prayer and a Jewish chapel. It currently houses a library and an arts centre.

#### 9 Kuldīga St. Anna's Ev. Lutheran Church

The newest place of worship in the town. The church features stained-glass windows and paintings by various artists from the period of the first Latvian Free State. There is a garden next to the church with a small stage for summer events.

#### 10 Kuldīga St. Trinity Roman Catholic Church

The foundation stone of the church was laid in 1641 in the presence of Duke Jacob. The church features among the most ornate interiors of any Catholic church in Kurzeme.

#### 11 Kalku Street Quarter

You can learn about beer brewing and coffee roasting, as well as the process of building a piano at the piano workshop of Dāvids Kļaviņš. A venue for culture and gourmet events.

#### 12 Kuldīga Artists' Residence and Gallery
