



KULDĪGA - A UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE

On September 17, 2023, the historic old town of Kuldīga was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List. This recognition honors the outstanding and authentically preserved urban structure from the 13th–18th centuries, with medieval streets, wooden and brick architecture characteristic of the Duchy of Kurzeme.

Kuldīga is the only preserved urban ensemble of its kind in the Baltic region, untouched and cohesive. Its value is also demonstrated by a long-standing commitment to heritage preservation, from restoration policies to public involvement.

UNESCO status strengthens Kuldīga's global importance and supports sustainable cultural heritage development.

VISIT AND ENJOY

- Ventas rumba / Venta Rapid**
Europe's widest waterfall, with a width of 249 m and a height between 1.6 and 2.2 metres. In the spring and autumn, fish can be seen "flying" over the waterfall. As dusk sets in at night, Ventas Rumba is illuminated. On selected weekends, with prior notice, light shows are held over the waterfall.
- The Old Brick Bridge over the Venta**
The third-longest (164 m) brick-arch vehicle bridge in Europe, built in 1874. It was built 500 feet long and 26 feet wide and designed so that two horse carriages could pass each other.



- Alekšupīte Waterfall**
Latvia's highest natural waterfall (4.15 m). In the 17th century, it was reinforced and developed to power the first paper mill in Kurzeme.
- The Town Garden**
A recreational area featuring 22 sculptures by the sculptor Līvija Rezevska. Located in the oldest part of Kuldīga, on the site of the former German Order and later Duke Jacob's castle.
- Kuldīga District Museum**
A house locally known as Bangerts' Villa. The second floor's exhibition is arranged as an apartment, styled as an early 20th-century upper-class Kuldīga apartment, while the third floor features the historical exhibition "Kuldīga Before Us."

- Exhibition of the open collection of the Kuldīga District Museum 'Journey to the Museum Collection'**
On the 2nd floor of a building of the historical Bank of Latvia of Kuldīga branch, an open collection exhibition is displayed, consisting of six thematic parts. It offers the opportunity to explore the non-exhibited objects of the museum's collection.

- Kuldīga Old Town Hall with Town Hall Square**
The Old Town Hall was built in the second half of the 17th century and housed a prison in its dungeons. Today it hosts a weaving studio, an exhibition hall, an open fire hearth, and the Kuldīga District Tourism Development Centre.

- Kuldīga St. Catherine's Luth. Church**
Kuldīga's oldest church (1252). A chance to climb the tower for a bird's-eye view of the town.

- Art Centre and Library**
The former synagogue complex, consisting of three buildings – a synagogue (1875), a house of prayer, and a Jewish chapel. It currently houses a library and an arts centre.

- Kuldīga St. Anna's Ev. Lutheran Church**
The newest church in the town. The church features stained-glass windows and paintings by various artists from the period of the first Latvian Free State.

- Kuldīga St. Trinity Roman Catholic Church**
The foundation stone of the church was laid in 1641 in the presence of Duke Jacob. The church features among the most ornate interiors of any Catholic church in Kurzeme.
- Kaļķu Street Quarter**
A creative industrial quarter featuring a brewery, coffee roastery, restaurant, piano factory, gym, art studio, and various artisan studios. A venue for culture and gourmet events.

- Stafenhagen House with an open fire hearth and a chest**
Legend has it that King Charles XII of Sweden once stayed in this house and left a large chest of clothes, which can be seen in the hallway. The largest open fire hearth in Kurzeme can be seen here.

- Kuldīga Old Town Garden**
In the courtyard of the Kuldīga Restoration Centre, a 19th-century style garden has been created with traditional fences, a greenhouse, and historical plant varieties. Five such gardens have already been established in the Old Town, enriching the city's cultural landscape.

- Live Museum "The story of Ancient Kuldīga"**
The interactive exhibition tells the story of Kuldīga in an interactive form about historical events during various periods.

- Needle exhibition at the Industrial Heritage Tower and viewing platform**
Part of the former Kuldīga needle factory "Metears". Features an industrial heritage exhibition and a rooftop platform with panoramic views of the town.

- Walking Trails along Venta**
2.5 km long walking trail along the bank of the river Venta connects the Old Brick Bridge of Kuldīga with the new bridge. Starting point: Pils street 8
2 km long walking trail from the Art Days Park to Black Kolka. The trails are also suitable for cyclists and parents with baby carriages.
- Mārtiņsala Beach**
A well-maintained beach with a recreation area for children and adults, facilities and changing rooms for summer and winter swimmers. Accessible for wheelchair users.
- Māras Pond**
Picturesque recreational spot right in the city center, featuring a well-maintained walking path around the pond and a comfortable swimming area for summer visitors.



- Kuldīga Sightseeing Tower**
The Sightseeing Tower in Pārventa Park offers panoramic views of the Venta Valley, its habitats, floodplain meadows, the river, and the town of Kuldīga. Visitors can enjoy the scenery from eight levels.
- Sightseeing Train "Ludis"**
The train runs almost year-round, offering a 40-min tour of Kuldīga's streets, historic buildings, and landmarks. Tours in Latvian with English subtitles. Boarding: Stendes Street 2a and Baznīcas Street 5, +371 24884888.
- Sightseeing Electric Bus "Rumba buss"**
Sightseeing (in LV, RU, ENG, and DE languages) by panoramic electric bus with a guide for groups and individual travellers, providing audio headphones for each participant.
